On the shaded terrace of historic Libbey Ranch, actress Reese Witherspoon's secluded seven-acre family retreat in Ojai, California, designer Kristen Buckingham surrounded a wood-topped dining table with vintage iron and wicker chairs. The lantern is antique. ▷







**5.** In a tranquil corner of a rambling Bel Air, California, estate, designer Kim Alexandriuk paired an 18th-century French stone table originally used by fishmongers with 19th-century carved stone benches to create a shaded dining area beside a fountain. The garden path is paved with reclaimed limestone. **6.** At the Hollywood Hills home of TV producer Jamie Tarses and her family, Pamela Shamshiri of the Los Angeles-based firm Commune maximized views of the city

by placing a custom table and chairs beneath a pergola; the floor is paved with cement tiles from Granada Tile. **7.** In the pool cabana of her family's Southampton, New York, beach house, which was designed by the architecture firm Sawyer Berson, decorator and furniture designer Kelly Behun sited a teak table and chairs by Bonetti Kozerki Studio in front of a stucco wall adorned with staghorn ferns and baskets made in Zambia. The floor is limestone, and the rug is from Morocco. ■
